3. What events does Peter link with what he calls “the day of the Lord”?
(vs. 10)
4. What question does Peter ask in the light of these events? (vs. 11a)
5. How does he answer his own question? (vss. 11, 14)

Read 1 John 3:1-3

5. What does John see as evidence of God’s love “lavished” on us?
(vs.1)

6. What can we as Christians expect from the world? (vs. 1b)
7. What can we look forward to when Jesus returns? (vs. 2)

What do you think this might be like?

8. Because of this, what does John urge us to do? (vs. 3)
