Into the Bible:

Read Isaiah 55:1, 2

3. What is God actually offering us here?
4. How does this compare/contrast with the things we have to buy?

Read Matthew 13:44-46

5. What is the key teaching, central to both these little stories?
6. What cost was involved in each story?
7. How did the two in these stories feel about the cost?

Read Philippians 3:4b-11

8. From a worldly standpoint, Paul seems to have a lot going for him. How did he now see those things others may have prized?
9. What changed Paul’s perspective?
10. What now is his one goal in life?

Read Philippians 3:12-14

11. Where did Paul see himself now, in his journey into God’s kingdom?
12. What is he determined to do?



Digging Deeper:

13. The man in Jesus’ first parable “stumbled across” the treasure unexpectedly; the merchant in the second story was actively looking for fine pearls. Which of these examples is closer to your own experience of discovering God’s kingdom?
14. “Forgetting what is behind... straining toward what is ahead... I press on...” (Philippians 4:13, 14) What do these phrases say to you and where you are in your spiritual journey right now?
