Getting Started:

1. Can you recall a time when you felt especially close to God?
2. Is this how your relationship with God is now?



Into the Bible:

Read Psalm 139:1-6

3. In what ways did David describe the depth of God's knowing him?
4. How do you think David felt about this? (See vs. 6)

Read Psalm 139:7-12

5. How does David describe God's presence with him?
6. Do you think this is a comfort to David... or a challenge?

Read Psalm 139:13-18

8. What does it mean to you that
 - A. God "created your inmost being"? (vs. 13)
 - B. God "ordained" your days on earth (and wrote them in his book?) (vs. 16)
 - C. God thinks about you? (vss. 17, 18)

Read Psalm 139:19-22

9. What a contrast to the rest of the psalm! What do these verses tell us about David and his circumstances?

Read Psalm 139:23, 24

10. Why do you think David asks God to search him again, and test his heart and his thoughts?



Digging Deeper

11. In what ways can we make David's example and his prayer our own?
12. "I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made." (vs. 14) Can we say this with David? How will this influence the way we live?
